Your Lawn Has Mushrooms

Mushrooms can be an annoyance on a lawn, but do not harm the grass and contribute to the breakdown of thatch and other organic matter. Mushroom spores are everywhere and after a prolonged rain or excessive watering they often develop into mushrooms. Controlling them is difficult and unpredictable. Fungicides are not effective and therefore cultural control methods must be used.

Our Recommendations:

1. Sweep or rake them off the lawn.

- 2. Remove any buried material such as logs or stumps.
- 3. Ensure a balanced soil PH and add lime if required.
- 4. Aerate annually to control thatch.
- 5. Water infrequently and deeply, allowing the top 1" of soil to dry between watering.
- 6. Improve air flow by pruning the base of hedges and trees.
- 7. Feed the lawn a regular balanced diet of nutrients.

These recommendations may help reduce mushroom problems, but complete control cannot be guaranteed.
